MPC understands the importance of this issue and is committed to the pursuit of responsible procurement practices and has no intention of, neither directly nor indirectly, abetting the human rights violations identified in the Democratic Republic of Congo (the "DRC") and adjoining countries.

Magee Plastics Company does not purchase raw ores or virgin metals nor does it utilize "conflict minerals," defined as gold, tantalum, tungsten, tin, cobalt and copper, derived from ores mined in either the DRC or certain bordering countries.

Magee Plastics Company will utilize commercially reasonable efforts to enhance its supplier audit to verify the source of raw materials which are incorporated into its purchases and metal components and seek sources which can assure that conflict metals are not incorporated into its purchased products."
